

Conceptual Note about the Webinar

As we know that the various professional social workers and social work associations have started a campaign to establish a nation-wide council and to enact a law to establish a “National Council for Social Work Education”. The prime objectives of this council are to enhance quality in social work education, including its linkages with practice, knowledge, and ethical conduct; to create national registers of accredited social work education institutions, programmes and professionals; to provide trained workforce for social sector; and to develop social work as a global profession. At present, there are more than 500 universities, colleges and institutions offering social work education programmes all over the India and around thousands of students enrolls in different academic level such as undergraduate, post-graduate and research every year.

More than 78 years has been passed since we started social work as a profession in our country, which is internationally recognized practice based profession that provide training to the students through scientific knowledge, skills and methods of working with people and systems and another hand, it is based on the knowledge of human relationship, democratic values and ethics but like other countries, it has not yet been recognized as a profession in India. The main reason for this is that there is no comprehensive and universal framework of social work.

Under the new education policy, giving importance to various role of social work specially in school setting and adult education which will give a new dimension and new direction to social work in the field of education. The webinar *on “National Education Policy 2020 and Social Work Profession” with special reference to National Council for Social Work Education Bill 2021* will focus on the issues and opportunities for social work profession in new education policy.


PROF. SANJAI BHATT
