Master of Computer Applications (MCA-21)

The counselling and document verification for the candidates who have qualified the entrance examination for Master of Computer Applications (MCA-21) program held on 01 Jan., 2022 is scheduled on **21 and 22 Feb., 2022** at the following centres:

The admissions for MCA are offered for Model Study Centre, Haldwani (Code: 16000) only. The medium of teaching is ENGLISH. The learners are directed to check the eligibility for the admission before attending the counselling:

- a. Passed MCA entrance test conducted by the Uttarakhand Open University.
- b. Passed BCA/ Bachelor Degree in Computer Science Engineering or equivalent Degree like PGDCA diploma from UGC recognised University, A- Level from DOEACC with graduation, etc. **and** obtained at least 50% marks (45% marks in case of candidates belonging to reserved category) in the qualifying Examination.

Or

- B.Sc./ B.Com./ B.A. with Mathematics at 10+2 Level or at Graduation Level **and** obtained at least 50% marks (45% marks in case of candidates belonging to reserved category) in the qualifying Examination. In this case, the candidate has to pass a bridge course of 1 year duration (DCA Program) before admission to 2-year MCA program.

- c. In case, the candidate does not had mathematics at 10+2 / graduation level, he has to clear an additional paper of Sr. Secondary: Mathematics By Dr. Rajendra Kumar Nayak, National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS) from SWAYAM. In this case, MCA degree will not be awarded without clearing this paper.

 - d. The candidate has to bring all the **original educational documents** starting from 10 onwards for verification along with the category certificate, if applicable. Following documents are required:
 - i. Completely filled Admission form
 - ii. Self-attested copy of Class X marksheet and certificate.
 - iii. Self-attested copy of Class XI marksheet and certificate
 - iv. Self-attested copy of Graduation marksheets and degree/provisional degree
 - v. Self-attested copy of Category certificate along with permanent residence certificate, if applicable

- vi. Self-attested copy of Aadhar card/PAN Card/Voter ID/ Passport/ Driving License
- vii. Passport size photograph
- viii. Bank Chalan of Rs. 11,150/- in favour of UOU for MCA(2-year program) or Rs.3250/- for Bridge Course

After verification of the qualification and other documents, the candidate will be advised whether bridge course is required as per the directions of AICTE. The candidate has to submit the application form along with the required documents and bank chalan (Rs. 11,150/- in favour of UOU for MCA (2-year program) or Rs.3250/- for Bridge Course) at the UOU Campus office Dehardun/ Model Study Center, Haldwani.

Please note that:

1. The admission is subject to verification of the original documents and payment of the fee. Merely qualifying the test will not entitle a candidate for admission. All the rules and regulations of Uttarakhand Open University regarding admission shall be applicable as and when required.
2. As per AICTE, the eligibility qualification for 2-year MCA program is as below:

“Passed BCA/ Bachelor Degree in Computer Science Engineering or equivalent Degree, OR Passed B.Sc./ B.Com./ B.A. with Mathematics at 10+2 Level or at Graduation Level (with additional bridge Courses as per the norms of the concerned University). Obtained at least 50% marks (45% marks in case of candidates belonging to reserved category) in the qualifying Examination

3. The candidates who were allowed provisionally to appear at the test are advised to submit the proof of their eligibility in the Documents Verification.
